



- Parc Vue benches positioned at the edges of the garden face a collection of bird houses and hummingbird feeders to create an intimate connection with nature. Bench arms assist patients and elderly in rising from seated positions.
- B Larkspur planters provide a place for cultivating herbs at an accessible height for wheelchair access.
- Solstice umbrellas, Catena chairs, and Catena tables offer a shaded place to socialize.
- **D** MultipliCITY path lighting defines primary walking paths at each edge of the garden.
 - MultipliCITY litters provide attractive options to conceal and recycle waste.
 - A water element near the seating area aids in the creation of a tranquil, calming setting.
- G Planting beds are interspersed between bench seating and walking paths at the center of the garden.
