General Description

- Peak is constructed from cast and extruded aluminum
- Available with solid or perforated panels
- Peak is rotationally adjustable
- Base or surface-mount table required

Mounting Options

- When used with a Landscape Forms table, Peak must be mounted to the table, which in turn must be mounted to, or embedded in, a hard surface.
- If used with a table other than those offered by Landscape Forms,
 Peak must be anchored to our surface-mounted stand.
- Peak may also be used without a table, but must be secured in our surface-mounted stand.

Finishes

 All metal parts are finished with Landscape Forms' exclusive Pangard II® polyester powdercoat – a hard, yet flexible, finishing process that resists rusting, chipping, peeling and fading.

To Specify

- Select perforated or solid panels, and powdercoat color(s).
- Specify to mount in Landscape Forms surface mount or embedded table.
- Specify surface mount stand if using with table other than those supplied by Landscape Forms, or if used without a table.
- Specify color for stand.
