


Take-Out Planning Guide

Designed by Rodrigo Torres, the family’s clean silhouettes and effortless mobility invite movement and discovery, encouraging users to shape the setting that fits the moment. This guide shows how Take-Out can support a spectrum of experiences, from intimate corners and casual meeting spots to active social hubs, outdoor classrooms and community gathering spaces throughout campuses, schools, parks and public environments.


The power of Take-Out lies in its adaptability. A range of silhouettes—including singles, doubles and triples, wheelchair-accessible triples, tall, wedge, and K–5 school scaled mini—gives designers the freedom to create settings that reflect the scale, posture and energy of the intended use. Elements can be placed independently or combined into long runs, face-to-face picnic-style arrangements, edge-oriented seating, café-style grids, faceted arcs and dynamic radial compositions. Umbrella-ready tops and connector brackets provide comfort and stability where needed, while the family’s lightweight nature ensures reconfiguration remains effortless. The concepts ahead demonstrate just a few of the many ways Take-Out can activate space, spark interaction and shape environments that feel welcoming, adaptable and uniquely suited to their context.




